



INTRODUCTION

Crouch Valley Koi Section is pleased to be holding an open show again this year. Whilst we are at the same venue, there are a couple of changes to please be aware of:

- The Nursery now has new owners and will become Perrywood Buckhatch Garden Centre
- Following conversations with the owners our show will be held in a different greenhouse which will enable exhibitors to bring their koi to the vats without passing through the garden centre details will be provided to entrants nearer the show date.
- All vats this year will be 2.8 metre

Of course, being under cover we will remain unaffected by any summer showers.

Following the success of last year's show, all the dealers expressed an interest in returning and we are in contact with them and others who we were unable to accommodate so anticipate having a good range of dry goods and fish.

Following issues last year, we feel we must, regrettably, remind everyone wishing to exhibit that as a section of the BKKS, our show is open to hobbyists only and, in accordance with BKKS rules you must own all koi you enter (ideally, these should have been in your own pond for a minimum of 30 days).

For the sake of clarity, CVKS class you as a dealer if:

- You receive a primary or secondary income from the sale of koi
- You are a direct family member or employee of the above

Please note:

- As hobbyists, we all need to move a few of our own koi on from time to time this is not dealing to make an income
- Also, a part of the hobby for many is to buy a box of koi to grow on, keep the best and sell the
 rest under these circumstances we do not see you as a dealer <u>BUT</u> if you are doing so in larger
 numbers we do
- Similarly, hobbyists will buy up the koi from a pond closure, keep the ones and sell the rest. This is ok <u>unless</u> you are doing so on a regular basis. We will treat the latter as dealing
- Trading in dry goods only or undertaking pond maintenance will not be seen as a dealer.

In order to protect the spirit of our show being for hobbyists only and to avoid a repeat of issues seen previously, we will ask all entrants to confirm on trust that they are not a dealer <u>and</u> are only exhibiting their own koi.

If you attended the show last year, you will recall it was a cracking two days with lots of quality koi on display across 26 vats and our unique painted trophies up for grabs and we are confident or repeating that this year with your support. Given we had a waiting list for vats, please do not delay in applying. You will know that koi shows are at the heart of our hobby, being enjoyed by existing koi keepers and providing a platform to attract new hobbyist. We are therefore very grateful to those koi keepers who exhibit their prize koi.

The Garden Centre is situated at Rettendon Common near Chelmsford. This very large and very popular garden centre has huge numbers of customers attending every weekend offering a built-in audience. The venue is located close to the A130 which can be accessed from the A12, A127 or A13 all of which have exits from the M25. BHN is a very close neighbour of RHS Hyde Hall and, as in previous years, we have timed our show to coincide with the flowers show they are holding. So, if you or the family are keen gardeners, take a look their website and perhaps take in two shows in one weekend.

There is a popular café on site that serves a wide range of food from all day breakfasts, sandwiches, jacket potatoes and main meals, plus a full range of hot and cold drinks available. For those with a sweet tooth, they have a fantastic selection of home baked cakes and biscuits from classic cakes like victoria sponge to gluten free brownies.

Tea and coffee will also be available in the members area of the show arena for all participants in the show.

Show Sizes – Whilst we are aware the BKKS are reviewing show sizes, at the time of preparing this pack, they remain unchanged and we will therefore be following the existing table of sizes below with the exception of size 8; Size 7 & 8 will be combined for the purposes of this show.

Show Awards - The awards at the show are broken down into distinct categories and follow the judging procedure.

- The first set of awards are the 'In Class' awards and are awarded to the top 3 koi in ALL of the 13 show classes and ALL 7 size classes. First, second and third are awarded in each group.
- The second set of awards are the 'In Size' awards and are awarded to the top 3 koi in ALL of the 7 size classes across the 13 show classes. First, second and third are awarded in each group.
- The third set of prizes are the Major Awards which will be:
- Grand Champion
- Mature Champion
- Baby Champion
- Best Non Go Sanke
- Adult Champion
- Jumbo Champion
- Superior Champion
- Young Champion
- Best Doitsu

Two further awards will also be made:

- As in previous years, Crouch Valley will be remembering Keith Holmes of Koi Water Barn, a valued supporter of the club over many years and will provide a trophy to the winner of Best Kawarimono.
- In memory of the late Mark Gardner, a former member of CVKS and valued member of the koi community, an award will be made to the winner of the Best Showa.

There will also be additional awards available to Crouch Valley members only:

- Best unique in memory of passed member, Jim (Jimbo) O'Brien
- Best Vat
- Best Show Newcomer (open to 1st time exhibitors from CVKS)



SHOW TIMINGS – PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ

Benching will take place on Friday 1st August.

We will NOT be benching online this year – all benching will be done by our team on the Friday.

Vats will be available for you **from 10.00 am to 8.00 pm (at the latest).** Please arrive as early as possible to aid the benching team and to give your koi the best chance to settle in the vat. If you are delayed, please ensure you contact our Show Chairman, Alan Hurley on 07973774587 (we are restricted by the venue opening times and they are already allowing us late access)

Prior to the show you will be sent instructions by email including how to access the venue.

You will directed to your vat by our vat manager and must not release fish until instructed to do so.

Please pay careful attention to bio security and disposal of your dirty water which must not be emptied into your vat for the wellbeing of your koi.

Please ensure you do not exceed the max number of koi and points permitted for your vat size (see vat booking form) as if you do, you will be asked to remove fish to meet the requirements.

DO NOT enter the centre ring.

Fish Health - **All koi entered in the show must be in good health**, not be deformed, have no visible signs of infection and may not be long finned or short bodied. Exhibitors will be asked to take home koi that do not adhere to these requirements. The Show Chairman reserves the right to authorise treatment/s for koi on health grounds for individual koi or a vat for the duration of the show from the moment the koi are benched to de-benching. As a BKKS Section, the rules, terms and conditions of the BKKS will apply to the show.

Note – In addition to water changes, we will also use an ammonia blocker for the added protection of your koi and will also deploy salt should the need arise. We will where possible consult with you before doing the latter.

De-benching - will begin after 4pm on Sunday, 3rd August, after the awards ceremony. For bio-security and to avoid any delays in departure you are advised to bring you own nets to speed up the preparation process of your koi for their return journey home The Crouch Valley team will be available at all times to assist with this process. Oxygen will be available if you do not have your own supply.

Please note – by submitting a request for a vat, you are confirming:

- You are not a koi dealer (as defined in the exhibitor pack)
- You are exhibiting your own koi only
- You accept the terms and conditions of entry and the rules of the show

A vat will not be allocated without the declaration above, the information requested below and payment in full. Do not assume a vat has been allocated unless you receive confirmation.

Please note:

- The maximum number of fish in a vat is 14 and the maximum points for a 2.8 metre vat is 50
- Whilst size 7 and 8 are combined for judging, a size 8 fish still counts as 16 points (not 13)
 - O Size 1 = 1point, size 2 = 1.5 points, size 3 = 2 points, size 4 = 3.5 points, size 5 = 6 points,
 - o size 6 = 9 points, Size 7 = 13 points, size 8 = 16 points
- Vat fees are £40

Please be reminded of rule 13 – No active feeding of koi for at least 5 days before a show

Notification of withdrawal from the show once a vat has been allocated must be no later than Friday, 18th July. This will enable us to hopefully reallocate your vat. <u>Fee will only be refunded if the vat can be reallocated</u>.
